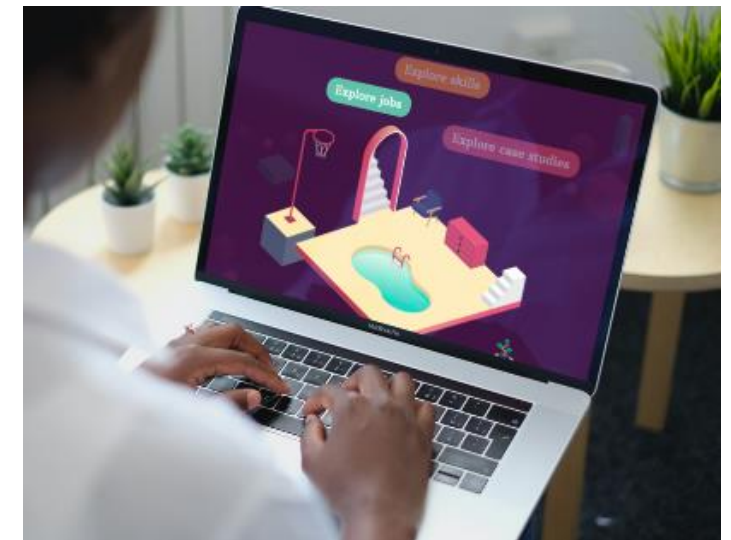
What is the Curiosity Museum?

The Curiosity Museum is available as a live pop-up workshop and a web-based digital experience. Or... choose a combined Live and Digital experience programme for maximum impact!





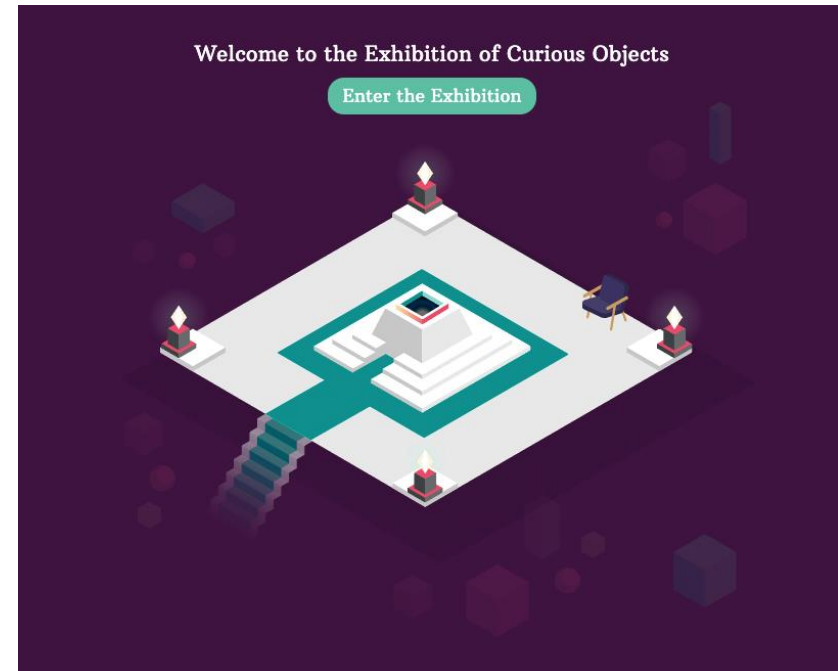

How does the Curiosity Museum work?

Our powerful coaching process gets to the heart of what students are good at and what they enjoy.

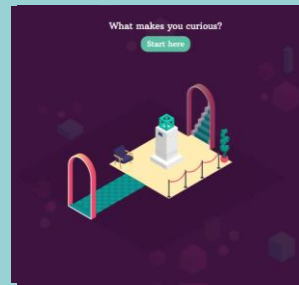
Each student creates a personalised action plan containing a research and development pathway for them to follow.

Students explore three zones, picking a museum object that takes them on a journey to uncover their skills and job possibilities.

The three zones



Curiosity Zone



Discovery Zone



Future Zone

Jobs are explained in short films and animations, including interviews with young adults who share their personal career insights and advice for pupils.
